





Surgeon Specific Registry Practice Improvement – Quality Case Data Review and Reflection 2022



This activity provides various opportunities for surgeons to best collect, review, reflect on, and learn from their surgical case data including outcomes data continually. Identify trends, gaps, etc. by comparing your individual case data to aggregated data.
