- 2) Quality matters – elevate your surgical quality performance by identifying trends, gaps, and improvement opportunities.
- 3) Exchange experiences with the PII peer surgeon group led by PII surgeon moderators and collaborate safely on improved surgical patient care solutions.
- 4) Utilize PII for ABS (*American Board of Surgery*) Continuing Certification requirements.
